Since reopening after our 2-year covid closure we have welcomed and cared for another 45 residents and families for a total of 578. 2023 marks our 32nd year in operation. 2023 also marks a change in leadership at Advent House. Glenda Hastings is leaving a long legacy as director and the role is now shared by RNs Molly Shanto and Brenda Ferraro. The generosity and dedication of our staff, precious volunteers, churches and our community has made this house a loving place of peace and solace for the dying and their families. It is a privilege to be part of this wonderful ministry to the dying.

Advent House is an outreach ministry of Perinton Ecumenical Ministries Inc, a corporation of thirteen churches in Perinton. We are a non-profit comfort care home that provides an alternative living arrangement for the dying when they can no longer be cared for in their own homes. Loving care is not only provided to them, but to their families and friends as well. We also make available bereavement services to the families of our residents for at least thirteen months after their loved one has died.

There are no fees to our residents and we receive no insurance reimbursement of any kind. While volunteers are indeed "the heart of the home", we could not function without the support of our community through donations of materials,

finances, time, prayers and participation in and support of our fundraisers. We are always accessible to our community as a resource for information or support and welcome your calls or visits.

We consider all of you Angels and we take this opportunity to thank you for your past and continuing support. Without you, we cannot function. Whenever we have put out a call for assistance, you have risen to the challenge. There are no words equal to the depth of our gratitude and the gratitude of those whom we serve.

Stock Donations to Advent House


